## Consistency of Actions

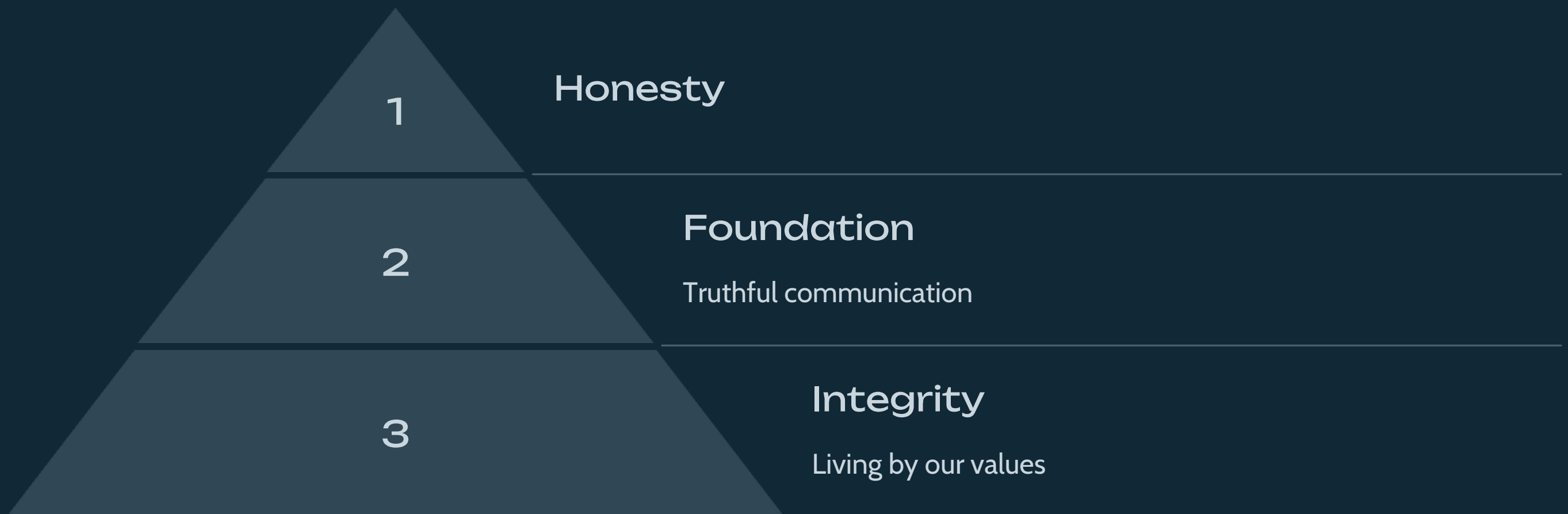
Acting in accordance with our values, regardless of the situation. It shows reliability and earns respect.
